



There are approximately 56,200 Jewish households in the San Diego Jewish community, according to Pew Research Center estimates. These households include 134,100 individuals, of whom 100,700 are Jewish. The Jewish population comprises 3.1% of San Diego County, and Jewish householders make up 4.6% of the households of San Diego County.



THEME 1: WHO IS A JEW?

Pew Research Center defines a Jewish household as households that include at least one Jewish adult. Jewish adults include those who consider themselves Jewish by religion or Jewish aside from religion. Non-Jewish adults include those who had a Jewish parent or were raised Jewish, along with those who have no Jewish background or affinity. Children are in turn classified based on whether their parents consider them to be Jewish.
